TE Force Majeure Notice Letter

Dear Valued Customer:

As you know, the Chinese government is taking significant steps to prevent the spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). The production capacity of companies in China has been seriously impacted unexpectedly. In addition to the impact this virus is having on domestic shipments within China, major global airlines have announced the cancellation of flights into the country. Therefore, these actions combined with the other negative consequences attendant with this situation we anticipate shipments in and out of China will continue to be impacted or delayed, which also has brought negative impact to the supply chain and logistics of our plant in Thailand. As a result, TE must respectfully advise that these circumstances constitute a Force Majeure event under all applicable rules and regulations.

Please be assured that TE is paying close attention to the events transpiring in China and is being sensitive to the needs of our employees, customers and suppliers in the region. We are evaluating our options to develop alternative solutions to assist you to mitigate possible impact of this Force Majeure event. We respect your needs and are willing to discuss these solutions with you. Please liaise with your TE sales representatives/customer service staff if your Orders have been impacted or are likely to be impacted by this Force Majeure event.
